George P. Barnes, Jr. was named site vice president – Hope Creek of PSEG Nuclear, in January 2007. He previously assumed the role of PSEG Nuclear’s site vice president, as part of the Nuclear Operating Services Agreement between PSEG and Exelon Corporation.

Mr. Barnes has over 36 years of military and commercial nuclear power plant experience. Prior to coming to PSEG he was site vice president at Exelon Nuclear’s LaSalle County Generating Station – a position he held since January 2002. At Exelon he had held increasing positions of responsibility, including Quad Cities’ plant manager.

Mr. Barnes also held various management positions while at Carolina Power & Light’s (CP&L) Brunswick Nuclear Plant, where he was instrumental in developing and implementing programs that resulted in dramatic station improvements. During his tenure at Brunswick he was licensed as a senior reactor operator (SRO). Mr. Barnes also served as plant manager at CP&L’s W.H. Weatherspoon fossil plant.

Mr. Barnes earned a Bachelor of Science degree in business administration from the University of North Carolina.
