Laura L. Brooks was appointed vice president - risk management and chief risk officer (CRO) for PSEG, in November 2002. She implements PSEG's enterprise risk management strategy and recommends methodologies for assessing and evaluating risk across all PSEG businesses. Ms. Brooks is an integral member of the risk management committee, which is responsible for managing the company's exposure to commodity, credit, foreign exchange, interest rate and other financial risks. She also manages the company's Sarbanes Oxley compliance implementation.

Ms. Brooks came to PSEG from PG&E Corporation, where she had been vice president - risk management. She is a member of the Committee of Chief Risk Officers, comprised of CROs from more than 30 corporations, which is aggressively working to develop reporting guidelines for energy companies to help restore the confidence of investors and ratings agencies. She currently serves on the advisory board for the quantitative finance program at Rutgers University, is a director of Provident Financial Services and the Provident Bank of New Jersey, and also serves on the board of the Girl Scouts of Greater Essex and Hudson Counties.

Ms. Brooks was previously employed at Deloitte & Touche as a senior manager; at Equitable Resources as director - corporate risk management; at Equitrans, an interstate pipeline, as vice president - reservoir engineering; and at Southern California Gas Company as a senior engineer.

Ms. Brooks has Master of Science degrees from both Carnegie Mellon University and Stanford University, and Master of Arts and Bachelor of Arts degrees from the University of Colorado.
