





Nelson Garcez, Jr. was appointed vice president – generation and technical services of PSEG Global (Global) in 2003, being responsible for Global’s domestic and international generation fleet. He had been vice president - Europe and North Africa, since January 2002.

Mr. Garcez joined Global in August 1997 in Brazil, and has held a variety of positions in business development and asset management; including country management in Brazil (1998/99), business management for the Mercosur region (2000), and business management for Europe, North Africa and the Middle East (2001).

Prior to joining Global Mr. Garcez worked for South America’s largest electricity distribution utility, Eletropaulo, where he was responsible for strategic planning and capital investments. He also was the executive director of the Sao Paulo State Energy Development Agency, and a member of the board of directors of Sabesp, the water utility of the state of Sao Paulo.

Mr. Garcez graduated from the Polytechnic School of Sao Paulo State University, Brazil, with a degree in mechanical engineering, and completed post-graduate studies in energy planning at the same university. He has also completed the Harvard University/Kennedy School of Government program of privatization and restructuring of the energy sector, and the Getulio Vargas Business School program on marketing of services.
