



Richard D. Machon was named senior vice president – Fossil operations of PSEG Power, in January 2008. In this role he is responsible for the overall operation of PSEG’s fossil fleet.

Mr. Machon has almost 40 years of experience in the power industry; including engineering design, construction, start-up and operations as well as business experience in the private sector.

Prior to joining PSEG Mr. Machon was an independent consultant to the industry. He has held positions of chief operating officer - nuclear for Ontario Power Generation; site vice president for TVA’s Browns Ferry plant during the recovery of Unit 3 and removal from the watch list; plant manager at PGE’s Trojan Plant; and early in his career at then Boston Edison’s, Pilgrim Station. Mr. Machon was also president of the startup team forming the joint venture, Impell Pacific, which delivered work management solutions to the industry.

Mr. Machon holds a Bachelor of Science degree in mechanical engineering from Northeastern University, attended the Executive Utility Management Program at the University of Michigan and is a Registered Professional Engineer.
