On May 26, PSE&G submitted its application to the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities (NJ BPU) to construct the North Central Reliability Project (NCRP), which would upgrade transmission lines and substations in the northern and central regions of the state.

As a follow-up to the filing, PSE&G has scheduled three public workshops to provide you with information about the planned upgrade. All workshops will take place from 4:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. You are welcome to attend the workshop that is most convenient for you.

We hope you will attend one of these workshops to speak with experts on a one-on-one basis and to learn more about this project, which is scheduled to begin in early 2012 with an in-service date of June 2014.

The project is designed to deliver the electric service that is required to meet current and future demand by New Jersey businesses and residents, as well as relieve transmission system overloads, provide better power quality and reduce transmission system congestion experienced in the region.
